Two Additional Children for Jabez and Lucy (Keep) Rogers

135 JABEZ⁵ ROGERS (Nathaniel⁴, John³, Joseph², Thomas¹) was born at Eastham 30 June 1727; in 1754 or before, he married **LUCY KEEP**. *The Rogers Silver Book, Volume 19: Part 1*, lists nine children born to the couple. Two additional children, Asa Rogers [#677A] and John Rogers [#680A], have been identified; both men married and had children. Their complete biographies will be included in the forthcoming *Rogers Silver Book, Volume 19: Part 3*.
